Accommodation: Students Accommodation at the campus at the top floor, double rooms with bathroom en-suite, app. 35€/double room (if you share, the price is half), elevator, Address: 2100 Gödöllő, Páter Károly utca 1. (map/coordinates on the last page)

Costs: All costs at your charge, except coffee, tea and water, will be available in the institute.

Monday evening: traditional pot-luck dinner, in connection with the actual agricultural land-scape, if possible (in this case it means: fish). Lunches are at one of the university canteens (if you are here early on Monday, let me know if you wish to have a common lunch. I will make a reservation accordingly, the same goes for Wednesday, before everybody leaves).

Traveling:

- **Nearest airport:** Budapest Liszt Ferenc International Airport with several low-cost airlines. It is important that there is a fixed rate for taxis (to avoid overpricing, we have our "own" local taxi driver if you want, I can ask him to pick you up, the same price of course), so it is the best if you can combine your arrivals and take one shared taxi. I always offer one tour by myself, if we can arrange it and the timing does not coincide with other activities, e.g. if you arrive on Sunday evening, I can make one turn to the airport and back.
- **Nearest train station:** Gödöllö with direct connection to Budapest. 5-10 minutes walk from the institute/dormitory.
- **Nearest bus station:** Gödöllő city center with fast bus to Budapest. It is appr. 5 minutes from the train station on foot.
- Local train: only if you like challenges, it is much longer, much shakier, and less safe. Sorry to say.
- Car: parking at the university campus is free. All students started to travel by car in the last 2-3 decades, so sometimes the parking lot is full but there is always a spot. Alternatively, you can also leave your car at the institute.


